The older sibling must attend grades F-5 at the school being applied to during the coming academic year, must be registered as living at the same address as the younger sibling, and must live within two kilometres' walking distance of the school being applied for. It is the residential address stated in the population register that applies. It applies whether the siblings are biological siblings or not. Independent schools have their own selection criteria. Please contact the independent school to which you have applied for more information.

**Upon admission to and placement at a particular school, the written consent of both guardians will be required.**

If your child has not been placed at the school to which you applied, the decision has been made in accordance with Chapter 9 Section 15(2) (preschool class) or Chapter 10 Section 30(2) (primary school) of the Education Act. The general rule is that a child shall be assigned a place at the school of its guardians' choosing. However, the municipality may reject this request if it would entail significant financial or organisational consequences for the municipality. An example of when a requested placement can entail financial or organisational difficulties is when the number of applicants to a particular school exceeds the number of places, as stated in the preparatory work for the Education Act. The demand for school places exceeds the number of places available, and the municipality has therefore made a selection in accordance with the City of Stockholm's agreed selection criteria <https://grundskola.stockholm/>.
